



Knowing as Integration: Clues, Focus, Submit

John Frame: multiperspectivalism approach (Tri-Perspectivalism): Existential, Situational, Normative—The knower, the object being known, the criteria for knowing

How we understand clues:

1. The World —deciphering the clues around us— What is noise and what is music?
2. The Self—“Obedience is a lived truth” —How do we incarnate knowledge?
3. The Rules—The role of authority—Whose directions do we follow and why?

Putting the clues together: Integration and Transformation
