- 1. You children need to see their sin so they will cry out for God's mercy.
- 2. Your children need to understand the nature of sin, so they do not minimize its danger.
- 3. Your children need to understand that their problem is not with their parents, but with God.
- 4. Your children need to understand that sin is a nature problem that produces behavior problems.
- 5. Your children need to understand that since sin is a heart problem, the only solution is a new heart.
- 6. Your children need to be taught to run to the only place of hope: The forgiving grace of God.
