COMMON CONFESSION OF SIN SCRIPTURE OF EXHORTATION: Galatians 5:13-15

For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." But if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another.

All: Lord God, eternal and almighty Father, we acknowledge before your holiness that we are poor sinners, born into guilt and corruption, prone to do evil and unable of our own power to do good. Because of our sin, we endlessly violate your holy commandments. But, O Lord, with heartfelt sorrow we repent and turn away from all our offenses. And in removing our guilt, also grow us daily in the grace of your Holy Spirit, and produce in us the fruits of a life that is pleasing in your sight, through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Sermon Questions

- 1. Why is skepticism a fool's errand? How do we avoid this pitfall?
- 2. How does knowing, fear, and anger all come in to play? What is the Christian response to this?
- 3. How does worship help us to make sense of the world around us?
- 4. When we seek to know something, it requires a certain amount of risk. We have to have "a passionate commitment to trust things we cannot fully justify at the time of our effort."—Esther Meek. We cannot have a knowledge of God without the risk of involvement of a relationship to our God. Have you struggled with this at times in your walk with the Lord?
- 5. How does knowing that we are known by God through His Son change everything for us? How does Jesus give us confidence to know the world around us?
