## Sermon Series: 1 Corinthians — Living in the Mess Pastor Lloyd Pierson, Ph.D. Living for the End — 1 Corinthians 7:25-40 (ESV)

<sup>25</sup> Now concerning the betrothed, I have no command from the Lord, but I give my judgment as one who by the Lord's mercy is trustworthy. <sup>26</sup> I think that in view of the present distress it is good for a person to remain as he is. <sup>27</sup> Are you bound to a wife? Do not seek to be free. Are you free from a wife? Do not seek a wife. <sup>28</sup> But if you do marry, you have not sinned, and if a betrothed woman marries, she has not sinned. Yet those who marry will have worldly troubles, and I would spare you that. <sup>29</sup> This is what I mean, brothers: the appointed time has grown very short. ## **Sermon Questions**

- 1. How can we live with a sense or urgency in serving the Lord?
- 2. Consider: "For those for whom Christian faith demands and is synonymous with a worldly agenda for aggressive social change, the way of Paul will appear embarrassingly weak and irrelevant. For those for whom Christian faith demands the development of interior piety first and foremost, the way of Paul will appear to be substandard, a worldly compromise."—Vincent Wimbush. How does this reflect on our current social climate? How do we live in the tension between these two positions?
- 3. In 1 Timothy 5, Paul advises Timothy to encourage widows to marry. What might account for the different counsel given to these different groups?
- 4. Protestants as a whole undervalue singleness in ministry, yet church history is filled with single men and women serving the Lord in profound ways. How might we to a better job of encouraging this type of ministry?
- 5. How do we develop contentment in our lives? What makes this a challenge?
